
We will also have a selection of uniform for you to take/check in the hall.

Reception


Nursery have been doing lots of counting this week in our maths lessons. We have been learning the number rhyme "Five speckled frogs". The children have been making frogs in the playdough and counting them. We have been talking about one more and one less and matching the correct numeral to the amount of frogs.

This week reception have been learning all about butterflies, we have completed some amazing writing on the life cycle of a butterfly and made beautiful patterns on butterflies wings in maths.



Year 5 have had another busy week. As part of The Lowry Creative Writing Challenge, we were invited to visit the Lowry theatre for a tour. The children were fully engaged as they explored the art gallery and were able to create their own artwork inspired by L.S. Lowry's sketches and paintings. In maths lessons they have been measuring and drawing angles. The children estimated the size of angles and then used protractors to check their accuracy.
